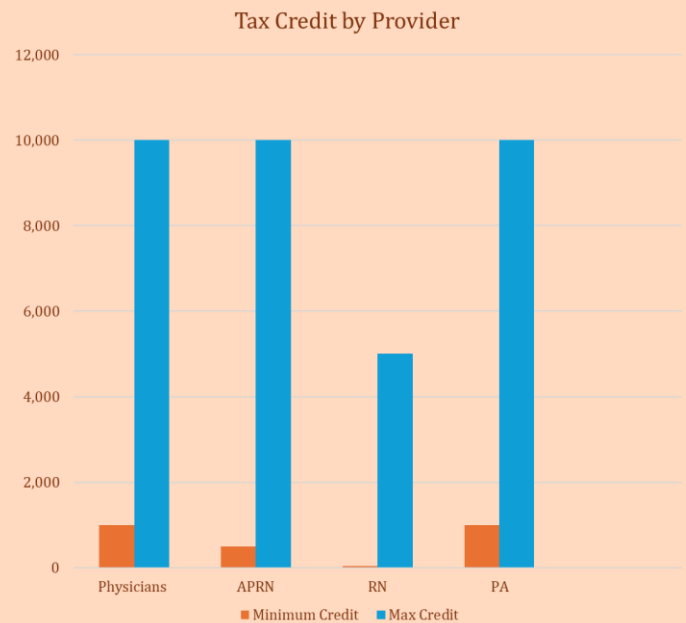
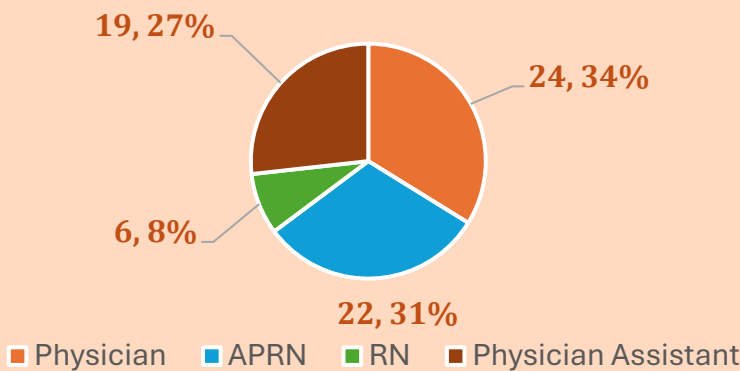
Preceptors are essential in assisting nursing students, novice nurses and experienced nurses to new areas of practice.
